Good morning to our viewers in the West. It is Wednesday July 22nd 2015. Welcome to CBS this morning. A deadly plunge for an American athlete. Dramatic video reveals what went wrong at an extreme sports event.

This morning, the US embassy in Turkey confirms the death of an American base jumper in a horrific fall. Wing-suit jumper IAN FLANDERS was participating in the International Culture and Nature Sports Festival in Turkey. Video shows him plummeting towards the ground. Mark Phillips is in London with the parachute mishap that cost Flanders, his life. Mark, Good morning.

Good morning, well, this is why they call them death defying jumps. Sometimes death wins. It's been doing that a lot lately. He was a 37 year old base jumper and wing suit flyer who was taking part in an extreme sports event in Turkey. The event was being carried by a local TV station. The gorge of the Karashu or "dark water river" in the eastern part of the country provided a dramatic venue for a pastime that is as spectacular as it is dangerous, although participants like IAN FLANDERS prefer to see the bright side. His first jump went fine.

Flanders' last jump wasn't fun. His luck ran out. When he pulled the chute chord, the lines apparently got tangled around his legs. We won't show the end of the jump. A flotilla of rescue boats retrieved IAN FLANDERS' body. It was taken to a local hospital. "Another victim of the thrill rush that is claiming too many victims" says the editor of OUTSIDE Magazine Grayson Schaffer. "The BASE jumping and, especially the wing suit community, is facing a real epidemic right now. Wing-suiters are dying at a rate that is, you know, unheard of in any other sport."

The world of BASE jumpers and "squirrel suit" flyers is a small one, and getting smaller. Flanders seen here on an earlier flight, was the 264th jumper to die since records have kept. His death is not just tragic, it was ironic. "At the time of his death, Flanders was actually working on a documentary about all of the deaths that have been happening in the BASE world, and... it's just an incredible tragedy that he would die this way"
